<b>Programme Title and Provider</b>	<b>Bail supervision</b>
<b>Details of all Specific national or local scheme/intervention(s) available</b>	Not currently available in Renfrewshire, but being explored. New guidance and information sharing processes are underway.
<b>Possible Outcomes</b>	
<b>Process for Assessment and/or inclusion in scheme/intervention</b>	
<b>Where no specific scheme/intervention is available, is there capacity to provide a bespoke service based on judicial request? Please provide details</b>	No, we do not currently have relevant multi-agency processes/staff in place to deliver this safely.

<b>Possible Outcomes</b>	Community reparation, addressing range of criminogenic needs through other activity, i.e. addictions/mental health/employability. Specific squads for light duties/women with chronic issues/sexual offenders or those at risk.
<b>Process for Assessment and/or inclusion in scheme/intervention</b>	Level 1 standalone order – no assessment required. Otherwise, assessment regarding suitability will be within Criminal Justice Social Work Reports.

**COMMUNITY PAYBACK ORDER: SUPERVISION**

<b>Interventions suitable for</b>	Available for all offence types for Renfrewshire service users. Male and female aged 16 years+.
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<b>Programme Title and Provider</b>	<b>Supervision</b>
<b>Details of all Specific national or local scheme/intervention(s) available</b>	Available for all offence types for Renfrewshire service users. Male and female aged 16+. Where individuals have been known to child protection services, accommodated etc. then this will be provided by Whole Systems/Youth Justice services.
<b>Possible Outcomes</b>	Support, guidance, assistance and dynamic risk assessment. Addressing range of reasons for offending.
<b>Process for Assessment and/or inclusion in scheme/intervention</b>	Assessment re-suitability will be within Criminal Justice Social Work Reports. For those aged under 18, Criminal Justice Social Work Reports and interventions will be undertaken by the relevant team. For women these will be delivered by the women's service – see below.

**COMMUNITY PAYBACK ORDER: PROGRAMME**

<b>Interventions suitable for</b>	Men aged 18 years+ where convicted of sexual offences+ subject to Community Payback Order supervision requirement/licence.
<b>Programme Title and Provider</b>	<b>Moving Forward Making Changes</b>
<b>Details of all Specific national or local scheme/intervention(s) available</b>	Moving Forward Making Changes available for Renfrewshire service users, men aged 18+ where convicted of sexual offences and assessed as appropriate on the basis of specialist risk assessments.
<b>Possible Outcomes</b>	Addressing reasons for sexual offending, and relevant wider issues.
<b>Process for Assessment and/or inclusion in scheme/intervention</b>	Assessment regarding suitability and eligibility will be within Criminal Justice Social Work Reports carried out by the Pathways service.

<b>Interventions suitable for</b>	Women aged 18+ subject to Community Payback Order supervision requirement.
<b>Programme Title and Provider</b>	<b>Connections</b>
<b>Details of all Specific national or local scheme/intervention(s) available</b>	Connections focuses on a holistic approach, integrating a number of theoretical and practical models centred on the individual as a whole and emphasising affective cognitive and behavioural change.
<b>Possible Outcomes</b>	
<b>Process for Assessment and/or inclusion in scheme/intervention</b>	Assessment regarding suitability as a programme requirement will be within Criminal Justice Social Work Reports provided by the Women's Community Justice Service. This is generally utilised as a higher tariff disposal for women, as an alternative to custody.

**COMMUNITY PAYBACK ORDER: TREATMENT: MENTAL HEALTH**

<b>Interventions suitable for</b>	Males and females, aged 16 years+ subject to Community Payback Order supervision requirement.
<b>Programme Title and Provider</b>	<b>Treatment: mental health</b>
<b>Details of all Specific national or local scheme/intervention(s) available</b>	Available for all offence types for Renfrewshire service users. Male and female aged 16+.
<b>Possible Outcomes</b>	Managing/addressing significant or lower level mental health issues.
<b>Process for Assessment and/or inclusion in scheme/intervention</b>	Assessment re-suitability will be within Criminal Justice Social Worker Reports on the basis of mental health assessment as to appropriateness for intervention and planned service provision. A Community Payback Order Mental Health Treatment Requirement requires a specialist mental health assessment and intervention. There will be individuals who already obtain, or require lower level mental health support, through GPs or Community Mental Health Teams; this would be managed through the supervision requirement.

**COMMUNITY PAYBACK ORDER: TREATMENT: DRUGS**

<b>Interventions suitable for</b>	Males and females aged 16+ subject to Community Payback Order supervision requirement.
<b>Programme Title and Provider</b>	<b>Treatment: drugs</b>
<b>Details of all Specific national or local scheme/intervention(s) available</b>	Available for all offence types for Renfrewshire service users. Male and female aged 16+.
<b>Possible Outcomes</b>	Managing/addressing addiction issues.
<b>Process for Assessment and/or inclusion in scheme/intervention</b>	Assessment re-suitability will be within Criminal Justice Social Worker Reports. A Community Payback Order Drug Treatment Requirement is a higher tariff disposal, requiring an addiction service assessment as to appropriateness for intervention and planned service provision. Lower tariff problematic drug use requiring counselling will be managed through the supervision requirement.

**COMMUNITY PAYBACK ORDER: TREATMENT: ALCOHOL**

<b>Interventions suitable for</b>	Males and females aged 16+ subject to Community Payback Order supervision requirement.
<b>Programme Title and Provider</b>	<b>Treatment: alcohol</b>
<b>Details of all Specific national or local scheme/intervention(s) available</b>	Available for all offence types for Renfrewshire service users. Male and female aged 16+.
<b>Possible Outcomes</b>	Managing/addressing addiction dependency and related issues.
<b>Process for Assessment and/or inclusion in scheme/intervention</b>	Assessment regarding suitability will be within Criminal Justice Social Worker Reports. A Community Payback Order Alcohol Treatment Requirement is a higher tariff disposal, requiring a specialised alcohol service assessment of alcohol dependency. Reporting on planned intervention and service provision. Lower tariff problematic alcohol use requiring counselling will be managed through the supervision requirement.

<b>Possible Outcomes</b>	Managing/addressing significant addiction issues related to offending. Combined with court social work service to allow early identification and entry into treatment
<b>Process for Assessment and/or inclusion in scheme/intervention</b>	Assessment regarding suitability will be within Criminal Justice Social Worker Reports. This order requires an addiction service assessment.
