

## Statement of Public Task by Community Justice Scotland

- 1. This statement sets out Community Justice Scotland's Public Task for the purposes of the Re-Use of Public Sector Information Regulations 2015 (the '2015 Regulations')
- 2. We operate under the terms of the Community Justice (Scotland) Act 2016.
- 3. Our public task comprises all the functions set out in the Community Justice (Scotland) Act 2016. These include:
  - a. Promoting the national strategy in relation to Community Justice
  - b. Monitoring, promoting and supporting improvement in performance in the provision of community justice, particularly in relation to the nationally determined outcomes, and to keep Scottish Ministers informed about this performance.
  - c. Promoting and supporting improvement in the quality and range of provision of community justice, and making the best use of facilities, people and other resources to that end
  - d. Promoting public awareness of the benefits of:
    - i. Community sentences over imprisonment or detention, and
    - ii. Managing and supporting people to not offend in future, or at least to reduce future offending

- 5. This statement is regularly reviewed and is due to be considered again in July 2021.
